60 Club Na Rampě
 A music club, intriguingly situated in an old cinema, hosts a wide range of music styles and wild parties.

61 Woko Club
 A music club with an incredibly diverse programme that suits everybody - movie screening, interesting lectures or Saturday night fever - just take your pick!

62 Eppl Club
 Don't know where to go partying? Electro music, DnB, HipHop, dance battles... everything is here in Eppl.

63 Břízky Sports Centre
 The right space for sport freaks - indoor golf courses, tennis, badminton, and squash courts, a football pitch and a running track, all in one place.

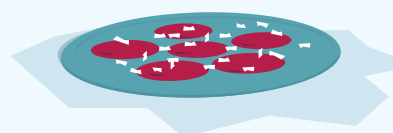
65 Museum of Glass and Jewellery

 A huge plus of this restaurant is its location. It's part of a guesthouse on the shore of the lake.

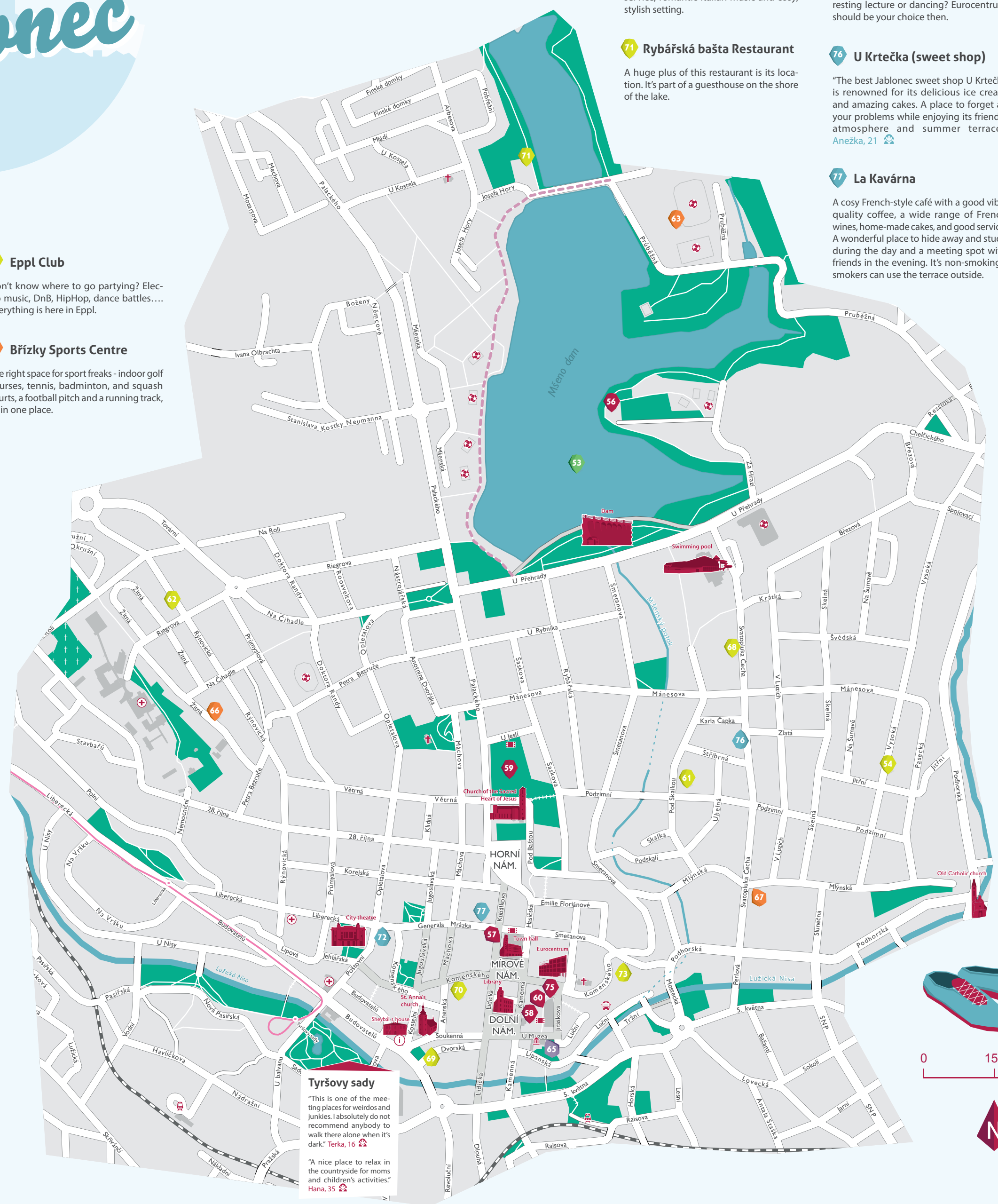
72 Level One Café

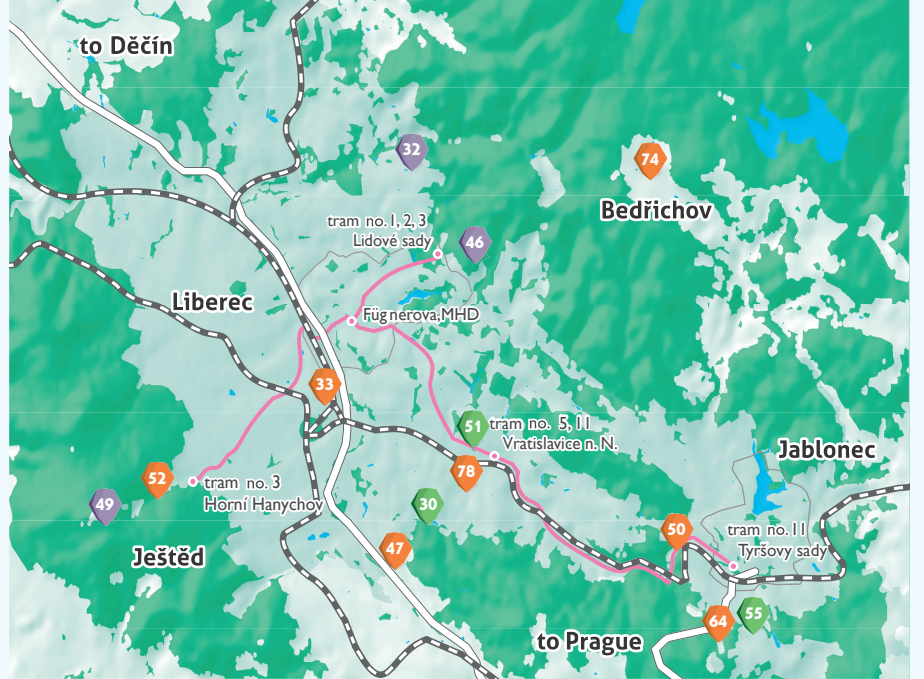

30 Tajch Pond
 Swimming in summer, skating in winter and a nice relaxing walk all year long, that's Tajch!

32 U Obrázku (church)
 During a short climb up the church path you'll get the impression that you've entered another world. There's a great view on the top as your reward.

33 Home Credit Arena
 At Home Credit Arena you can do a variety of sports, take in an ice-hockey or basketball match or go to concerts and other cultural events.

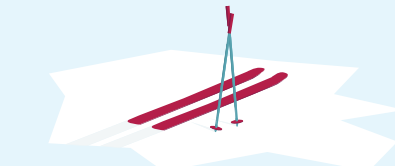
46 Liberecká Výšina (Lookout Tower)
 The reconstructed Liberecká výšina complex is one of the newest destinations for walks in Lidové sady. It first opened in 1901 and it attracts visitors by a nice restaurant, cultural events and a wonderful view of Liberec.

47 Vesec Cross-Country Ski Resort
 A great place for crosscountry skiing in winter and inline skating in summer.

49 Ještěd
 The Liberec spaceship was built in 1973 on the peak of Ještěd mountain. It is the best-known symbol of Liberec, an architectural treasure with a timeless design. You can get to the top by cable car, although the hard core prefer to walk "under the ropes", some of them every day in any weather. Every summer Ještěd hosts a festival with an extensive programme, including a vintage car show, concerts and more.

50 Climbing Wall
 A climbing centre with a pleasant atmosphere, student discounts, rental and a shop. They keep adding new climbing routes, and you aren't limited by time after paying the entrance fee.

51 Vratislavice Park
 This park, with its small lake, sandy footpaths and benches, is a perfect place to relax. Not far from here you'll find a forest park for kids with climbing frames, monkey bars, a nature trail through the trees and a little playground. It's a good place for jogging or taking a long walk away from the city rush. A perfect place to have a picnic.



52 Ještěd Ski Resort
 Where else can you meet skiers in a tram? They're probably heading for the slopes of Ještěd, where you can enjoy skiing with a wonderful view over the city in the valley. After skiing, go back to the centre of Liberec by tram to relax in some of the cosy bars and pubs.

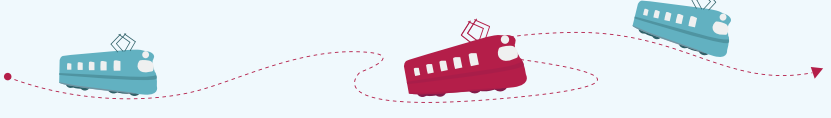
55 Petřín Lookout Tower
 One of many famous lookout towers in the region. They are connected with a network of rumber trails and are a wonderful reason to get out of town at the weekend and enjoy the countryside.

64 Dobrá Voda Sports Centre
 A ski resort and a bike park in one. Choose your level and go.

74 Bedřichov
 The starting point of a Giant Highway, an endless number of ski slopes and a great place for hiking.

78 Na Rozcestí Sports Centre
 A place with a pleasant atmosphere and prices, space for individual or group sports and a year-round skating rink. A little buffet with various meals is open for those who get hungry while doing sport here.

Liberec & Jablonec



"Either you're going uphill or it's raining." This sentence, which you will often hear from the locals, expresses not just the character of the town's but also their inhabitants' rough sense of humour. The north Bohemian cities of Liberec and Jablonec nad Nisou have histories in textile and glass industry, and are marked by their hilly topography and diverse architecture. The formerly German towns are linked by the River Nisa. Uniquely in the Czech Republic, you can travel from one to the other by tram. The country is also within easy reach, as both towns are considered gateways to the Jizera Mountains, full of viewing towers, vantage points and proper hills. No wonder the area is regarded as a skiers' paradise.

In Jablonec check out the Art Nouveau houses or unwind by Mšeno reservoir.

And how can you spend your leisure time up north? Jablonec nad Nisou and Liberec are characterized by their love of sport. The aforementioned ski resorts offer great services for downhill and cross-country skiers, both towns have swimming pools, cycle tracks and other sports facilities. There are also plenty of cultural opportunities in both towns. Jablonec is known for its club scene and staging various Medieval fairs and folk festivals, while Liberec is home to the excellent F. X. Šalda Theatre and Naive Theatre, which is a puppet theatre.

If you'd rather stroll around town you certainly won't be disappointed with the architecture as you soak up the character of these former Sudetenland cities during your wander. After all, Liberec was known as the capital of German Bohemia, and boasts a beautiful town hall, the historic Liebig quarter, superb villas, architecture emulating that of cities in the Austro-Hungarian Empire and the world-famous Ještěd.

If you meet any locals on your walks, don't be afraid to strike up a conversation. Pretty much every citizen will be happy to discuss the weather, the construction of new shopping malls in the centre or industrial past of their town. Visit the better known places or wander off the beaten track, but whatever you do keep your eyes open and take in the atmosphere of the places with their genius loci, of which there is more than enough in both towns.

Liberec

1 Šutr (climbing wall)

"In winter or bad weather, Šutr has to be your only choice :) Stretch your whole body and meet great people. All the equipment you need can be hired. And when you've had enough, grab a beer or a raspberry squash and watch those still going." [Terka, 26](#)

2 Starý Harcov Reservoir

3 Kamenná želva (tea room)

4 Café Bez konceptu

5 The Liebieg Quarter

"A town within a town. A picturesque area with a specific atmosphere and genius loci dating back to the blooming of the textile industry in Liberec." [Anče, 30](#)

6 Dobrá čajovna (tea room)

"A cosy place with an extensive cultural programme, where tea is served with love and the friendly staff will grant your every wish." [Pavlna, 26](#)

7 Budýšinská Park

The biggest park in Liberec is a meeting place for young people who just lie around chatting on the grass, have a picnic or try slacklining. You can check out some interesting historical artefacts in one of its corners called the Garden of Memories. If you get hungry, cross the road and get something to eat in the good-value Inter-spar restaurant.

8 Liberec Library

"A glass building full of light, a great place for reading and relaxing thanks to the comfy seats and peace and quiet." [Jifi, 17](#)

9 F. X. Šaldy Theatre

"The jewel in the crown of Liberec cultural life for all generations. Ballet, opera and drama all under one roof." [Pavlna, 26](#)

10 Malé divadlo (theatre)

Another possibility for theatre lovers! There's mostly drama on the programme. Thanks to its F. X. Kalby punk section and their alternative plays, Malé divadlo attracts young people who wouldn't normally go anywhere near a theatre.

11 U Hrocha (billiards)

U Hrocha is a perfect place to try some local beers and play pool at the student dorms.

12 Dandy Club

Another bar at the student dorms. You can choose between its café, tea house, pub or bar. A wide selection of board games to borrow.

13 Club Žito

Soak up the student atmosphere in Žito. They have cheap tasty pizzas and tank beer.



14 S - club

A complex of three connected and very different places to choose from – a non-smoking café with bowling, a restaurant and a disco. An ideal place to watch sports with your friends.

15 U Váchy Pub & Zanzibar

U Váchy – you can play pool, table football, cards, chess or ludo with your beer. When you get hungry you can grab something at the Asian bistro next door. The Zanzibar disco, well-known by the whole of Liberec, plays various kinds of music. You can even make requests to the DJ.

16 Had Club

The famous music club in Harcov student halls plays everything but mainstream – drum and bass, techno, electro, rock, metal, hardcore, crusty, hip hop etc. You're gonna love "The Hole" :-)

17 Tatáž Pakáč Pub

"Beer straight from the tanks and (not only) amazingly delicious smoked pork ribs will balance out the not always pleasant approach from the staff." [Monika, 18](#)

18 Ánanda (vegetarian restaurant)

A vegetarian restaurant with great food enjoyed by crowds of vegetarians and carnivores alike. Fifty percent discount from 5.30 p.m.

19 Jas (vegetarian restaurant)

If you're into healthy food don't miss this cosy little restaurant where you can eat in or stock up on goodies to take home with you.

20 Vokno Pub

21 Ene Bene Restaurant

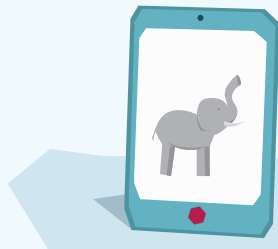

22 Bláha Bakery

25 Liberec Zoo

The oldest zoo in the Czech Republic attracts visitors with its famous white tigers, a pleasant stroll through the trees and endless attractions, not just for children.

26 War Memorial

A different kind of memorial. It has interactive sound and light elements and will draw you into the atmosphere of a battlefield. You can easily find it in the park by the army barracks.

27 Memorial to the Victims of Communism

A huge mirror for a memorial? You don't believe it? Go and check it out, it's definitely worth your while!

28 Coyote Diners & Bar

Real American burgers in a real American retro bar like those on Route 66 just a few steps from the main station.

37 Gallery 3x3

This gallery is part of Malé divadlo and offers temporary exhibitions of contemporary young art from Liberec and other parts of the country.

38 Jaroslav Fryč Bookshop

A bookshop with a soul where you can find excellent second-hand books and an internet café which offers an extensive cultural programme including travelling discussions and Sunday performances for kids.

39 Synagogue

A synagogue and the centre of the Jewish community on the exact spot where the old burnt-down synagogue once stood. It is part of the library and offers discussions and lectures on topics related to the place.

40 V-club

A youth club open in the afternoon has a free information service for young travellers and free table football, pool and board games.

41 Jahůdka (sweetshop)

A famous place with a huge choice of delicious cakes and other goodies. Great coffee and a chance to talk to elderly locals :)



42 Balada Restaurant

"Enter this space full of beautiful old things and tools that were used by our grandmothers and grandfathers and enjoy a daily special or one of the tasty salads." [Lucie, 35](#)

43 Naive Theatre Liberec

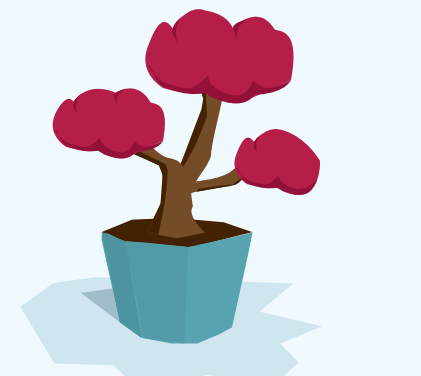
The former home of the famous Ypsilonika that moved to Prague. A puppet theatre with performances for both kids and adults.

Just sit down under this huge table laid for giants and wait for the bus. An idea that came from the famous Czech artist David Černý.

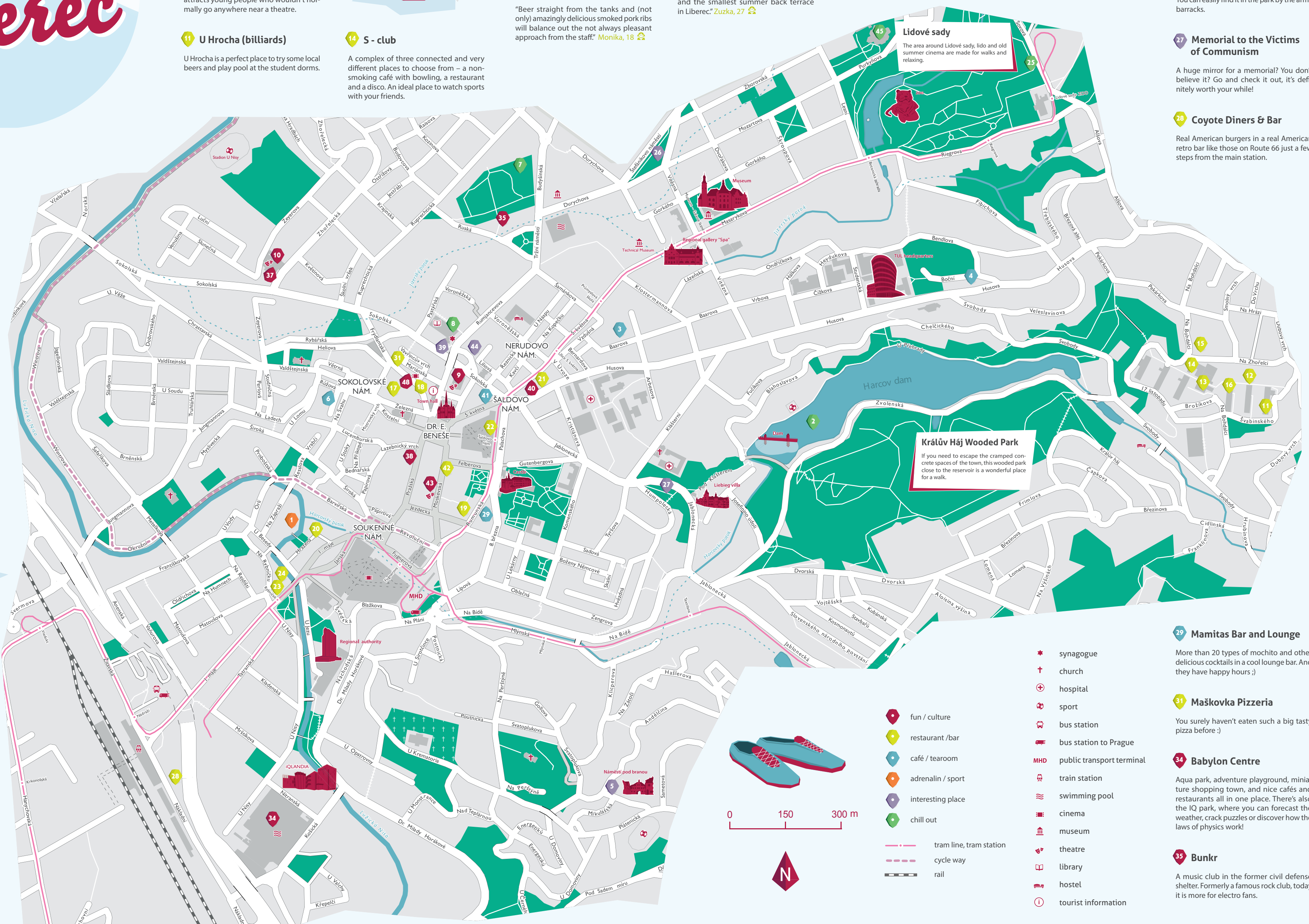
45 Botanical Garden

The oldest botanical garden in the Czech Republic has huge, beautiful greenhouses and aquariums full of sea monsters. A nice alternative during rainy weather.

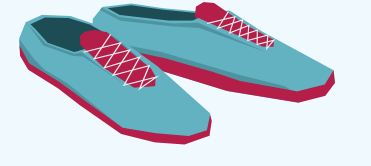


48 Zachraňme kino Varšava
