**47 Střelnice Stadium**  
"This place is well-known amongst fans of football and athletics. Athletic records have been broken here, and countless first league football matches have been played. The stadium's entrance is decorated with Barbora Špotáková's stylized javelin, and there's also a beautiful view of Jablonec and the Jizera mountains from here." *Stáňa, 39*

**48 Vilová street and its environs**  
A calm quarter of Art Nouveau villas offers from the beginning of the twentieth century, two of which were designed by the renowned

architect, Hemmrich. It's an ideal place for calm and contemplative walks.

**49 Church of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross**  
Whether you are an authority on architectural styles or just a keen enthusiast, you will appreciate the church and adjoining Husova street for their well-preserved, impressive architectural constructions in Art Nouveau style, with emphatic signs of the style of the Jablonec architects Josef Zasche and Robert Hemmrich.

**50 Villas of Jablonec**  
You can find this quarter, with its streets crossing at almost right angles, some of which are climbing steeply uphill, just a few minutes' walk from the main square. Just go for a walk and admire the sight of these majestic villas which were constructed during the period of German-inhabited Gablonz's industrial prime. You can find the most beautiful ones in Korejská, Liberecká and 28. října streets.

**51 Inner city circuit, the beginning of the path of Mr and Mrs Schejbal (6.5 km)**  
A marked route following the southern part of the town, passing the Petřín observation tower, which returns to the city center past ponds through a forest. The whole path is accompanied by signs focusing on interesting places. The terrace in front of the lookout tower offers a truly spectacular view of Jablonec.

**52 Paseky nad Nisou – Nisanka observation tower (2.5 km)**  
The route is used for jogging, but it is also excellent for a Sunday walk to somewhere with a view. It is a more demanding, hilly path.

**53 Proseč Ridge (5.5 km)**  
This path is used by walkers and joggers alike, and it's also possible to get from the point of departure to the destination by tram (stops Brandl and Vratislavice-koste). The terrain is hilly, rather demanding.

**54 Jizera Cross-country Route**  
Jablonec has the unique advantage that the Jizera Cross-country Route has one of its starting points almost in the center of the town. This departure point, however, is only kept in ready to ski condition when there is enough snow.

**55 Srnčí důl (1 km, possible to extend by further kilometers of paths leading through the woods)**  
A unique sports complex purpose-built in the nineteen seventies as a place to train the top athletes of the Czechoslovak national team. These days, it is a center for active recreation, equipped with tracks and courts, set amongst the scenery of the Jizera mountains.

**56 GB Beads**  
This cottage is located just a short way from the town, and is surrounded by picturesque scenery, including a view of Jablonec. A visit can be extended by a walk

to the source of the river Neisse and to the Nisanka observation tower.

**57 Museum of Armed Vehicles Smržovka**  
A very interesting museum full of diverse examples of army vehicles, some of which are operational.

**58 Mojžíšův pramen Restaurant**  
"A lovely place for trips, or just sitting outside with friends." *Renata, 54*

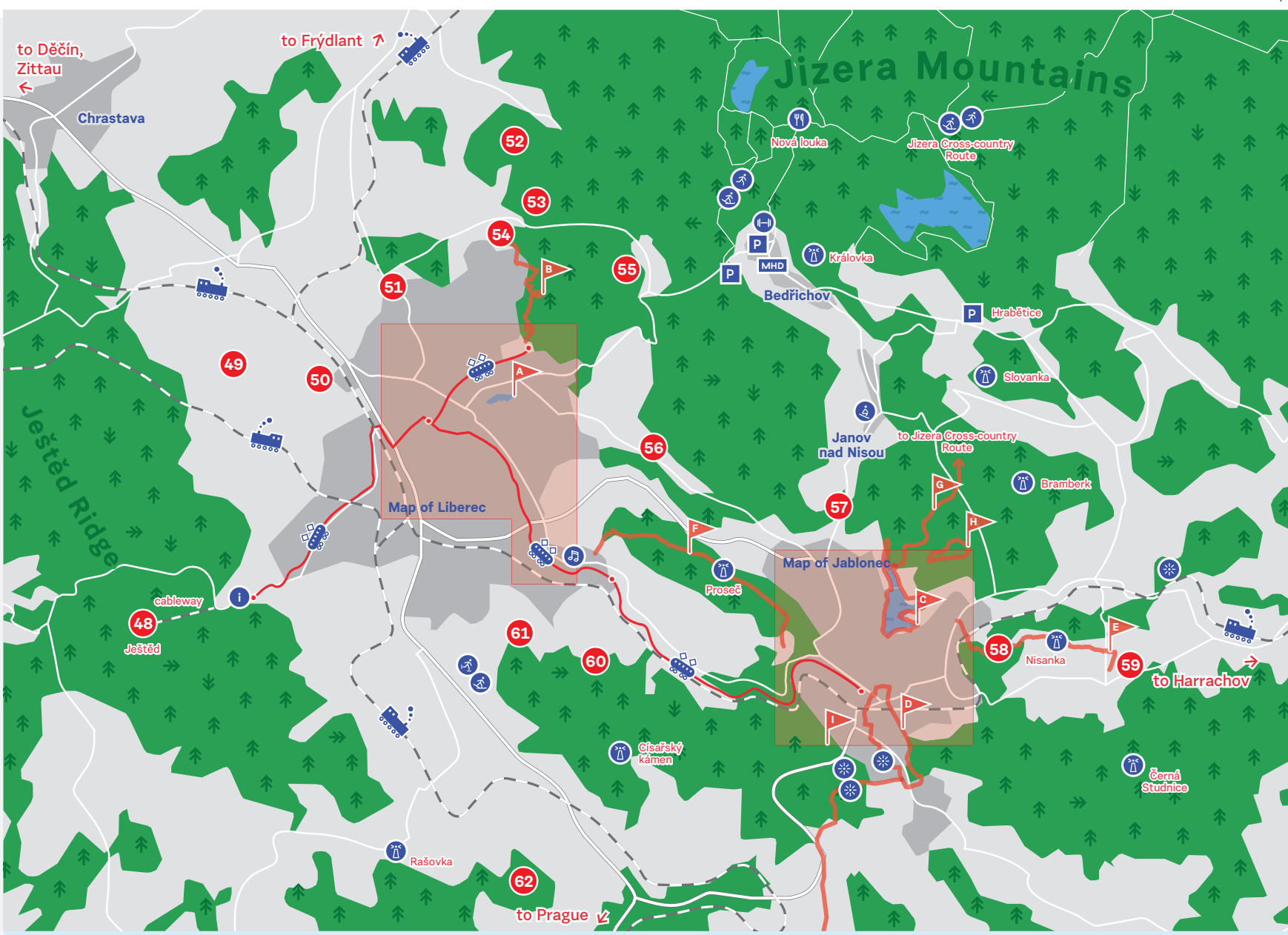


"The Proseč Ridge offers an exquisite view between Jablonec and Liberec. The view from the Proseč observation tower can be taken as a reward for the steepness of the terrain at the beginning of the journey (from both directions). You can meet cyclists, joggers and tourists as well on the path, and sometimes even horses. I like its calm and peace, although it's within walking distance of the public transport to both towns." *Jiří, 38 let*

Mlýnský náhon – This spot in Jablonec is truly fascinating. There's a beautiful dam built at the beginning of the last century with a view of the Jizera mountains. On top of that, there are beaches for swimming, paths for running, and a tennis track for in-line skating. Finally, in the winter, the ski runs of the Jizera Cross-country Route start here.

The Jablonec Pool: small but nice. You can swim here in a more intimate and pleasant atmosphere than in a giant water park." *Patřík, 45*

Would you like to see Jablonec from a bird's-eye view? Follow the green-marked hiking trail just 3.5 km and you'll reach the Černá Studnice lookout tower, 869 metres high and open year round. →



**48 Ještěd**  
"Ještěd is not only a symbol of Liberec itself, but also the whole region, and, in fact, even the Czech Republic. Everyone who visits Liberec should also visit Ještěd." *Lucie, 26*

**49 Prisoner of War Cemetery in Ostašov**  
"A memento of the First World War within the territory of Liberec. Infamous dramas took place in this town. There was a prisoner of war camp here for Italians and Russians, and many soldiers were buried there. The memorial is splendidly embedded in the landscape, and offers splendid views of Ještěd and the Jizera mountains." *Lenka, 36*

**50 Archa, Liberec Zoo's Center for Distressed Animals**  
Many of us like animals. So why not mix business with pleasure, why not do a good deed and help, for example, by taking dogs, placed temporarily in a shelter, for a walk? <http://archa.zooliberec.cz>

**51 Liberec Flower Exhibition**  
"This traditional exhibition takes place in the summer months, and I recommend it to everyone who enjoys cultivating plants. There are always more than a thousand different types of Fuchsia and hundreds of Pelargoniums." *Jana, 45*

**52 Dračí vrch**  
"There's a beautiful view of the whole of Liberec, including the Ještěd ridge in the background, from this place, which is not overly popular amongst hikers. There is also a view on the rocks, with a railing, from where you can also have a view in the direction of Hrádek nad Nisou and our German neighbors. It's also a great destination for a hike; although it's a more demanding walk uphill, it's relatively short. From here, you can walk on to the Fojtka reservoir or go for a beer at the brewery in Krásná Studánka." *Zuzana, 25*

**53 Forest Theater on Martinská stěna**  
"A fully equipped forest theater, what's more, with a scenic view. The stage set, perpetually waiting for a performance, is gorgeous, and the auditorium is in the open." *Zuzana, 29*

**54 Chapel of Virgin Mary "At the Painting"**  
"A magnificent place that reminds me of my childhood. If you walk up the Way of the Cross lined by chestnut trees, you can form a visual line of the chapel, the church of St Anthony of Padua and Ještěd: a beautiful view at sunset. Right behind the church, there's a well, which is said to have miraculously cured people. In my childhood, we often played in

the vast meadow at the church, and I can't forget the defense practice in school: we were running around the meadow, dressed in mackintoshes or plastic bags that earlier contained our greasy breakfasts, with fogged up gas masks on our face, trying to run over the 'polluted area' in fits of laughter. These days, the Ruprechtice Fair is organized here once a year." *Renata, 46*

**55 Žulový vrch**  
"If you endure the rather challenging walk uphill to the 'jammer' you can delight in fantastic views of Liberec. There is also a traditional ascent organized on New Year's Day with barbecue." *Nicol, 22*

**56 Vendelín Brewery**  
"There's something to getting on your bike after work in the summer and cycling your way on this undemanding road to a good unfiltered beer. And then going back on foot." *Karel, 38*

## Cafés of Liberec and Jablonec

Real cafés have arrived in Central Europe, and Liberec and Jablonec are no exceptions, with its oceans of coffeehouse contentment filled with the smell of freshly ground coffee, and with friends meeting and others answering their e-mails. There are more and more cafés where you can order a breakfast menu or go for Sunday brunch (e.g. La kavárna and Kavárna Pokec in Jablonec, or Bez konceptu in Liberec), and places offering home-made cakes and sandwiches are also becoming more frequent. In fact, some of them even offer lunches, like Mikyňa and Omam in Liberec. Just a few meters from the Liberec Town Hall, you can find a small botanical garden in Kafé Kytka: those green walls and the grass in the window are all real plants. And there is even something for real coffee aficionados: Sweet City sells its own roast under the Nordbeans brand, and also organizes coffee courses and workshops.

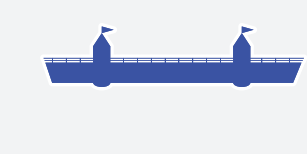

## 24 The Liberec Museum Quarter at the "golden cross"

Liberec's most impressive crossroads came into existence at the beginning of the twentieth century. This place, which is the beginning of the town's promenade leading to the Public Garden (Lidové sady), is surrounded by three lavish buildings, two of which, at present, are the homes of public collections. While the museum is being prepared for modernization, the building of the former public baths, recently rebuilt to house the collections of the regional gallery is amongst the most interesting architectural experiences that present-day Liberec can offer. Don't forget to take a look at the fourth corner of the crossroads, as well, where Masák's (1962) pavilion can be found along with two sculptures, the latter of which are a reminder of the unique 1969 exhibition, "Sculpture and Town." The newly founded Technical Museum completes the area's profile with its collection of displays recalling the rich industrial history of Liberec.

## 25 Liebig's Townlet

"A town in the town, so to say, offering unusual architecture, cozy nooks and interesting stories. This quarter, financed by Baron Liebig, is a rough equivalent of Baťa's housing estate in Zlín. The place has its own unique atmosphere, which is known not only to locals, but also film crews from the whole world who often shoot here. ## 26 Keil's Hill (Keilův vrch)

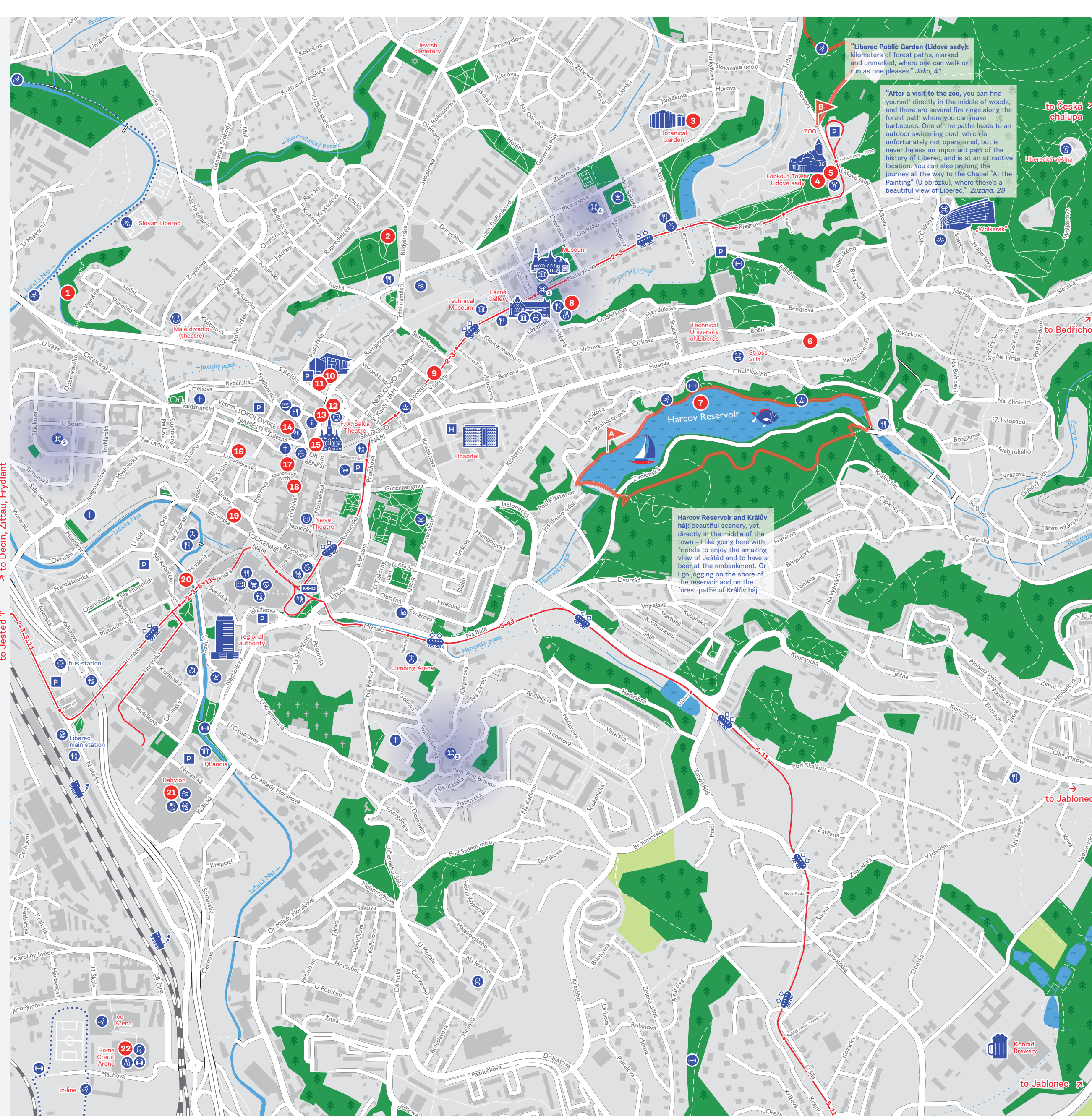

The area around Liberec and Jablonec has everything that's necessary to nurture a growing affection, and it is easy to find reasons to keep returning and discovering.
