The Liberec Museum Quarter

Liberec's most impressive crossroads came into existence at the beginning of the twentieth century. This place, which is the beginning of the town's promenade leading to the Public Garden (Lidové sady), is surrounded by three lavish buildings, two of which, at present, are the homes of public collections. While the museum is being prepared for modernization, the building of the former public baths, recently rebuilt to house the collections of the regional gallery is amongst the most interesting architectural experiences that present-day Liberec can offer. Don't forget to take a look at the fourth corner of the crossroads, as well, where Masák's (1962) pavillion can be found along with two sculptures, the latter of which are a reminder of the unique 1969 exhibition, "Sculpture and Town." The newly founded Technical Museum completes the area's profile with its collection of displays recalling the rich industrial history of Liberec.
